



Baby sneakers



Here is my step by step baby sneaker cake topper instructions. This topper can be made with fondant or gumpaste. What is great about this template is, that you can make these in any size you want by simply changing the format for your template. These cute shoe are perfect for a baby shower cake theme or even christening. They can be made for boys and girls by simply changing the colour of your fondant.

Step 1



Roll out white fondant or gumpaste and cut out #1 using the template as your guide.

Make sure you turn the sole template around before cutting the second shoe, so you have "left" and "right" shoes.

Step 2



Create this shape using white fondant and glue it at the front of your sole. (this will help your shoe to mold perfectly)

Step 3



Roll out white fondant or gumpaste and cut out shape #2 using the template.

Step 4



Brush the edge of the baby sole shoe with a small amount of water or edible glue and attach both pieces together.

Tip: Before gluing your pieces together let them air out for about 15minutes, this will harden your fondant and make it easy to work with.

Step 5



Using a different colour fondant, cut out piece #3. (You will use the same colour for all the other pieces of the template as well except for #1 and #2 which are white)

Step 6



Create a stitching pattern around your piece using a quilting wheel.

Tip: If you don't have such tool you can use a butter knife or even a lemon scraper to create the same look.

Step 7



Brush a small amount of water or edible glue on the inside of your shoe and glue #3

Step 8



Cut out piece # 4 using the template as your guide. Create a stitching pattern around your piece.

Step 9



Attach piece #4 to the front of #2 using a small amount of water or edible glue.

Step 10



Cut out piece # 5 using the template as your guide. Create a stitching pattern around your piece.

Step 11



Attach piece #5 to the top of # 4 using a small amount of water or edible glue.

Step 12



Cut out 4 times #6 using the template as your guide. Create a stitching pattern around them. Then, using a small amount of water, glue two stripes on each side of your shoe.

Step 13



Cut out #2 twice and create a stitching pattern around it. Then, glue each stripes at the top of #5 to create a Velcro effect look.

Step 14



Cut out # 8 and create a stitching pattern around your stripe. Then, using a small amount of water attach it to the back of your shoe on the top.

Step 15



Cut out #9 and create a stitching pattern around your stripe. Turn your piece around fold $\frac{1}{4}$ of it at the back of your shoe using water.

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
