Little man baby shoes



This is my little man baby shoes cake topper instructions. This cute topper can be made with fondant or gumpaste. You can make these in any size you want by simply changing the format of your template. With this said, you can also decorate your cupcakes by using a smaller version of this template. These shoes are perfect for a baby shower cake, 1st birthday cake or baptism.

Step1



Roll out white fondant or gumpaste and cut out #1 using the template as your guide.

Make sure you turn the sole template around before cutting the second shoe, so you have “left” and “right shoe”

Step 2



Create this shape using white fondant and glue it at the front of the sole. (This will help your shoe to mold perfectly)

Step 3



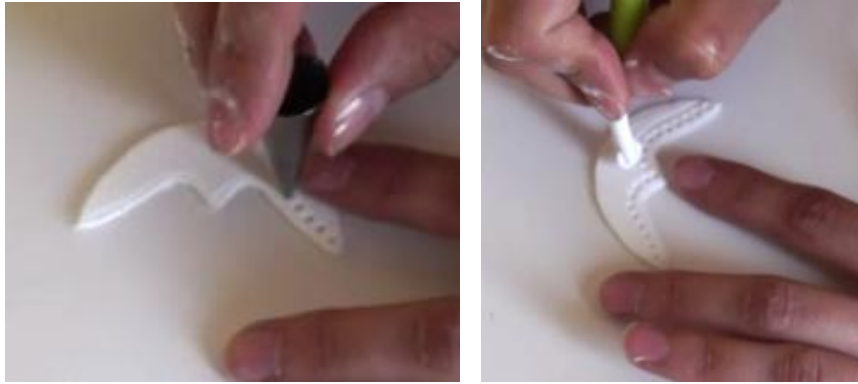
Roll out gray fondant or gumpaste and cut piece #2

Step 4



Using white fondant cut out #3. Create a stitching pattern in the front using your quilting wheel.

Step 5



Create holes under your stitching line using a piping tip. Then, stitch a second line under the holes using your quilting wheel.

Step 6



Glue #3 at the front of #2 using a small amount of water. (Water and fondant will create glue)

Step 7



Roll out white fondant and cut #4. Create a stitching pattern all around using your quilting wheel. Then, make holes under that line using a piping tip but only at the bottom of your piece.

Step 8



Stitch a second line under the holes using your quilting wheel. Create 2 holes on each side of your piece with a piping tip. (This will be for your shoe laces.)

Step 9



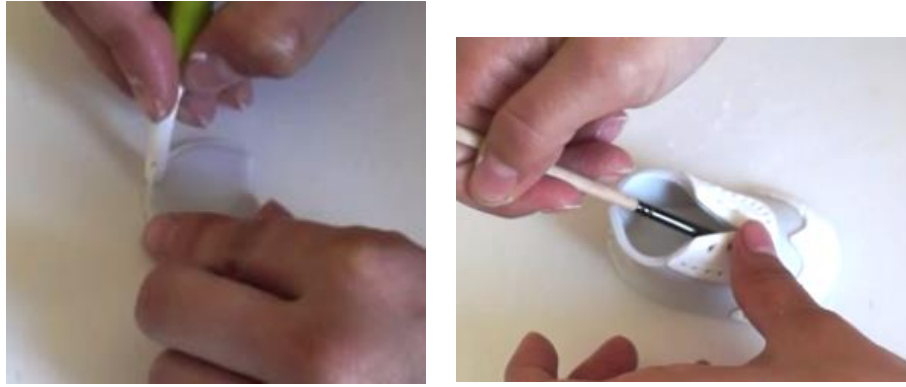
Brush a small amount of water at the back of your piece and glue it on top of piece #2.

Step 10



Brush the edge of the baby sole shoe with a small amount of water or edible glue and attach both pieces together.

Step 11



Roll out gray fondant and cut piece #5. Create a stitching pattern at the front using your quilting wheel. Brush a small amount of water on the inside of your shoe and glue piece #5.

Step 12



Cut two stripes of white fondant and glue them where you had made the holes.
